The viva-voce of the dissertation of M.Ed 2nd semester shall begin in the near future. All the students shall remain in touch with the department after submission of the dissertation. The students may also seek assistance of their respective supervisors and prepare for the viva-voce to be conducted by external examiner. The dissertation is to be evaluated out of 75 marks and viva-voce out of 25 marks on the basis of the performance of the students in the viva. Every student shall make a power-point presentation of the work done by them. It shall be done impartially and fairly to the satisfaction of everyone. The students are often confused on the questions to be asked at the time of viva. Few possible popular and tentative questions are suggested for preparation; you may tailor the questions with your dissertation work and prepare accordingly.
